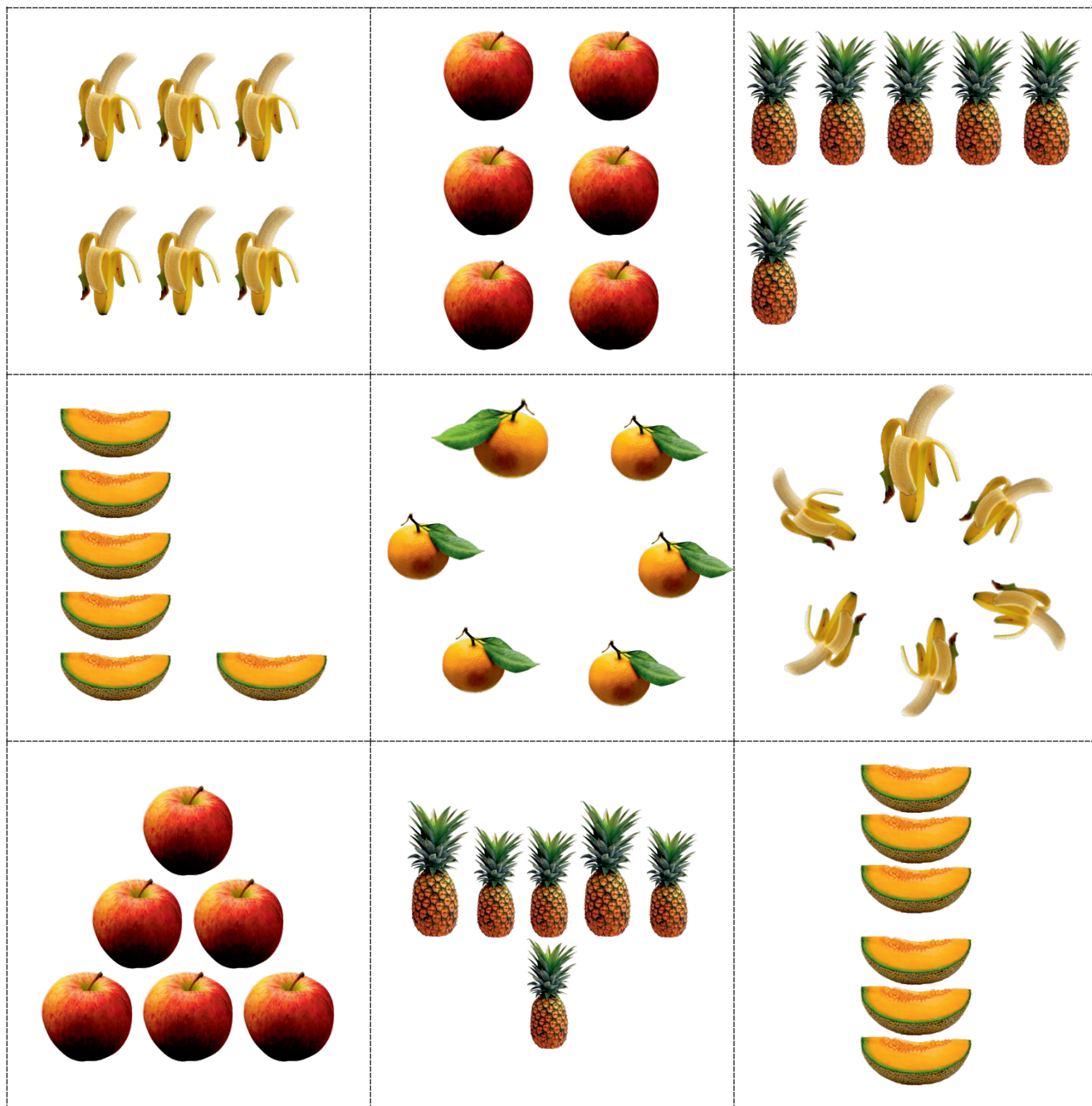

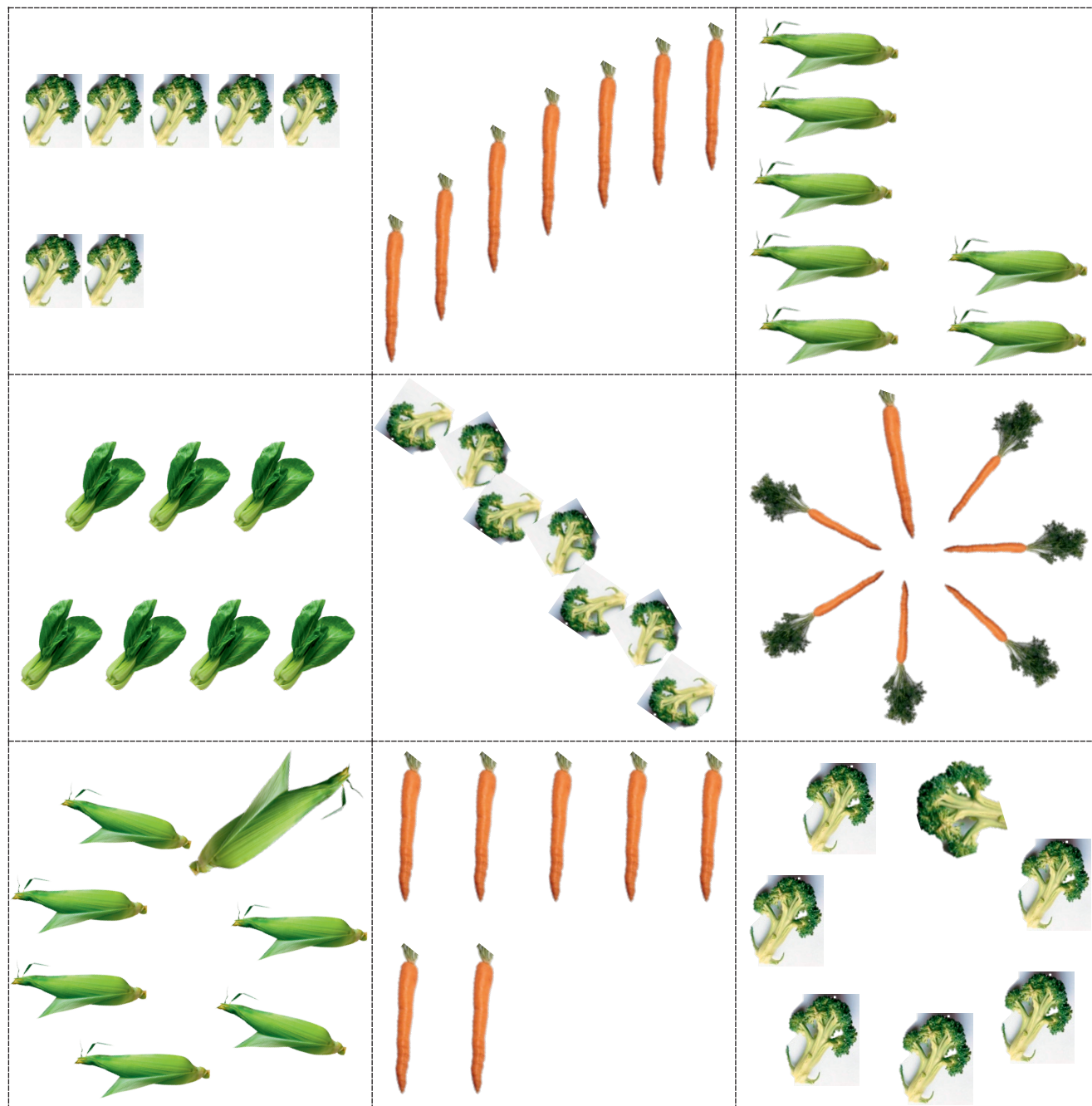

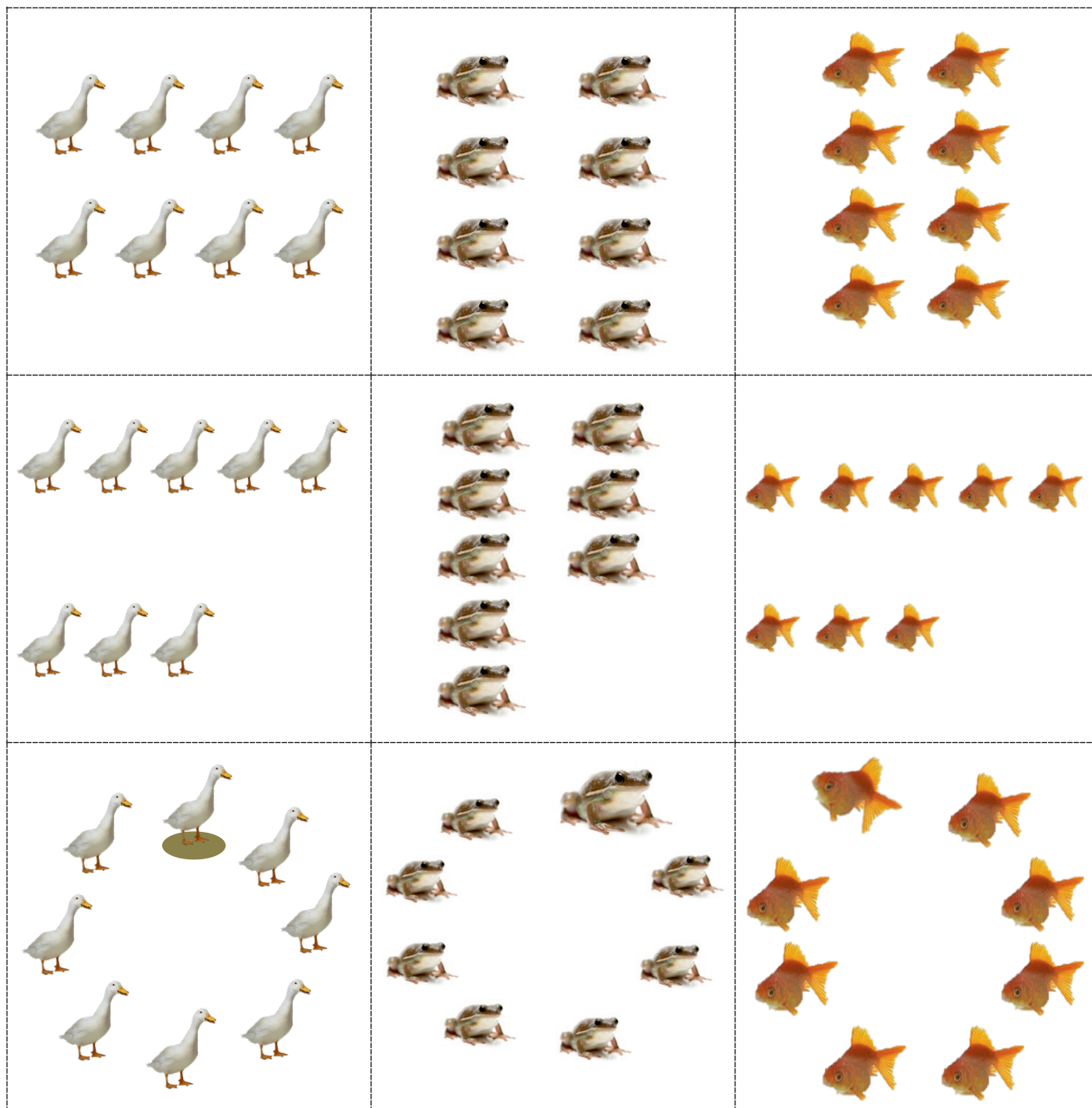

Cut along dashed lines. Put one 6-card and one 7-card in each bag.



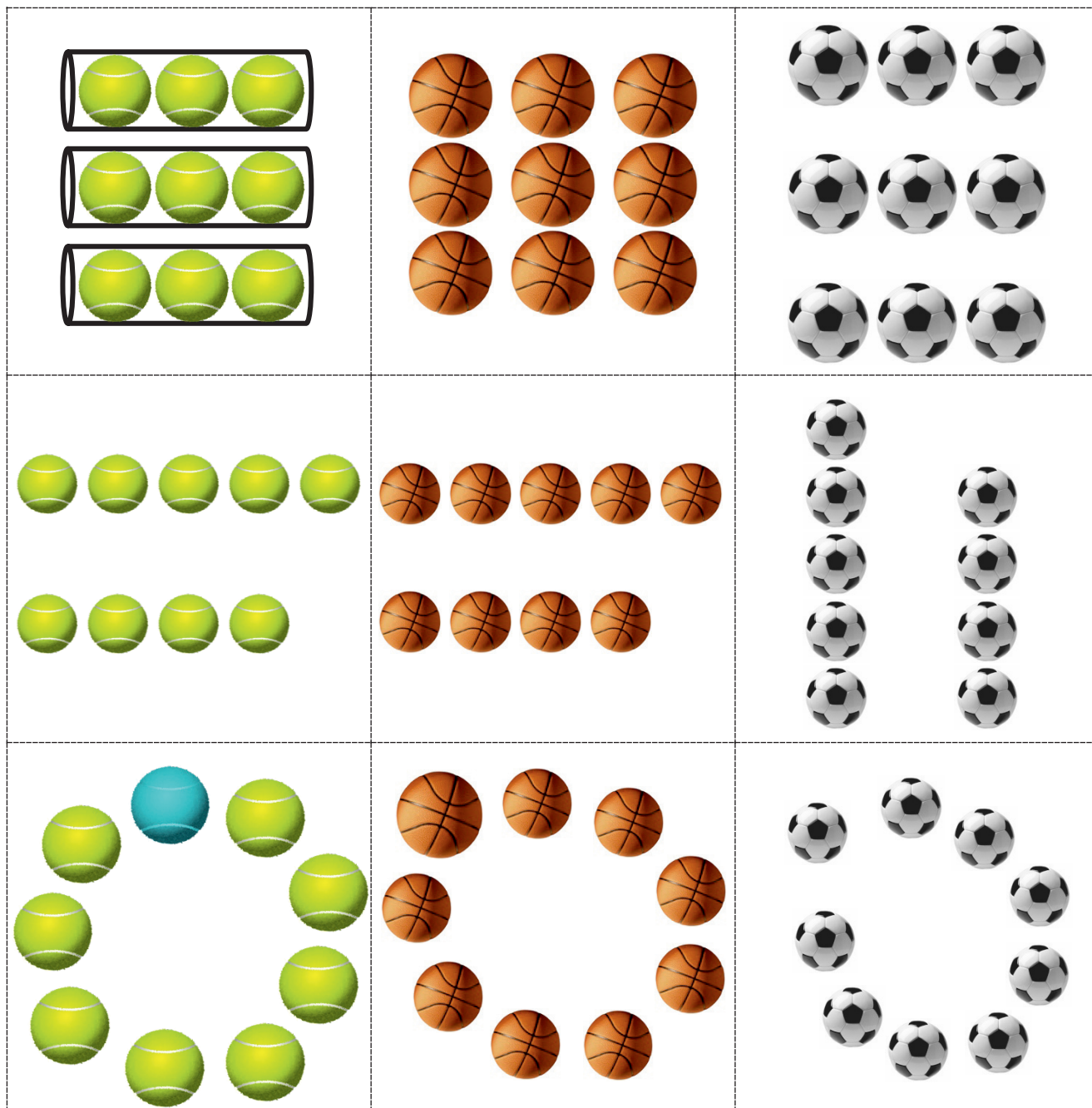

Cut along dashed lines. Add one 8-card to the bags of 6 and 7 that were used in Lesson 20.



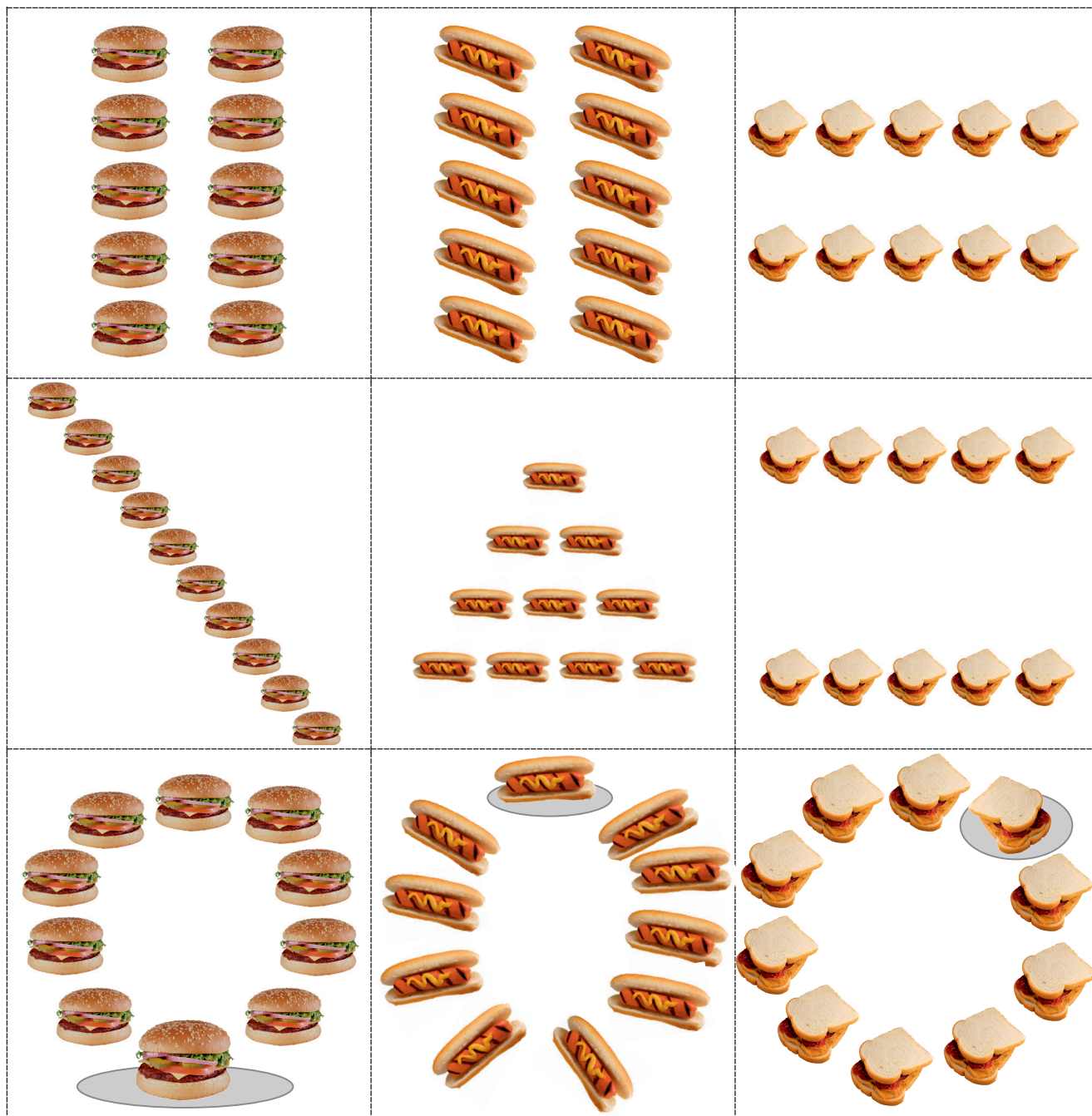
